When you register, you can mail in a check or we will invoice you for the total. You are permitted to make payments so as not have a large bill; contact Kathy Duffin to set up a payment plan.

If you are new to Community Integration, an assessment will need to be scheduled. Assessments last approximately ½ hour and the individual will need to be present. You can receive registration help at assessments and ask any other questions you may have. Assessments help us determine our staffing ratios as well as what programs will best suit the individual.
