Temporary Addendum to PACE Parent Notebook effective March 17, 2020

The safety and well-being of your family and program staff is of utmost importance to us. For that reason, effective March 17, 2020, the method in which all PACE early intervention services of Montgomery County Board of DDS is offered and provided to eligible families is through tele-visits. This temporary change is an effort to practice social distancing in support of local, state, and federal recommendations to combat the coronavirus pandemic. Suitable tele-visit offerings through MCBDDS as outlined by the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (ODODD) include video conferencing on HIPAA compliant platforms and audio calls on the telephone.

The PACE Program will resume the in-person service delivery method with interested families after receiving guidance from ODODD that it is safe to do so.
