Ensuring health and safety is our number one priority but providing a fun and engaging environment is close behind. We work with individuals with a variety of disabilities and ages.

We have two programs, an adult program and a children's program for ages 6-17. Both programs run all year long. During the school year, available work hours are in the evening and on weekends. There are a large numbers of hours available to work in the summer.

First Aid/CPR certificate will be required once employed (training provided by the Board).
