- HIPPA Notification
- Liability Release Form
- Consent for Publication
- Permission to Release Form

Family Support Services Program (FSSP) Money

- If you **have a waiver**, you will not be eligible for FSSP. Activities must be private paid.
- If you **do not have a waiver and are currently eligible for Family Support Services Funding**, you may use this money for recreation services with MCBDDS. The forms are included with the booklet.

Cancellations

If an activity is cancelled, you will be notified if/when that activity is rescheduled. If the MCBDDS agency is closed due to inclement weather, the activity scheduled for that day will also be cancelled. If you are unsure if a program is cancelled, please call (937) 918-2110 for a message concerning the activity. You may also visit our website to see if the agency or any activities are cancelled (www.mcbdds.org). If you have paid the activity fee, it will be credited to your account if the activity is not rescheduled. If you have used FSSP Funds to pay for the activity and it is cancelled, your account will be credited.

Refunds

You must cancel 2 weeks prior to the activity. If tickets have been purchased, we will try to fill from the waitlist. If we are not able to fill the spot, you are responsible for the payment.

Payment Deadlines

Trips and activities have deadlines for payment. **In order for you to participate, you must have the money in before the scheduled activity.** We will invoice you for the total. You are permitted to make payments in order to not have a large bill.

Assessments

Health and safety is important to our program. If you are new to Recreation, an assessment will need to be scheduled. This will help us determine how to best serve your child with their individual needs. Assessments will last approximately ½ hour and your child will need to be present. You can receive registration help at assessments and can ask any other questions you may have. Assessments also help us determine our staffing ratios as well as what programs will best suit your child. To make an assessment appointment, call Eddie Green (937) 918-2119.
