Falling under the concept of "Learning best when learning at their own pace."

Center Lane: This may be a good fit for participants who enjoy small group activities. Activities are staff led with assistance as needed, with some self directed learning through educational activities geared at individual levels. Activities such as participation in exercise class (cardio, drumming), fellowship with outside minister monthly, and an occasional community outing. As requested, fun socialization, working from the belief that allowing individuals to choose what they learn or to take part in for the day makes for a meaningful day as the choice is their choice what they will be engaged in throughout the day.
