



On Monday, April 8 there will be a solar eclipse.



This happens when the moon moves between the earth and the sun at just the right time.


During the eclipse, it will get dark like nighttime but only for a few minutes.

I can watch the eclipse outside if I want, but only with special glasses.



Or I can watch the eclipse on TV. My staff will help me figure out how to watch.

This happens when the moon blocks the light from sun.

For 2-3 minutes, it will be dark like nighttime. It might also get a little colder.

I will need special glasses to protect my eyes if I choose to watch the eclipse outside.




3D Glasses
